

Why is Collegerama so happy with it?

Collegerama has been recording lectures on Campus since 2004. Since the start, users of Collegerama have asked us to somehow make the laser pointer of lecturers visible in our recordings. This is almost impossible to do, for technical and practical reasons.

Collegerama captures the presentation slides digitally and since the Logitech Spotlight is a software based pointer, it will show both in the lecture hall AND in the recording. This provides a much better recording since viewers can see what a lecturer is pointing at in his/her presentation.

Use Spotlight on Windows or Mac, and on Powerpoint, Keynote, PDF, Google Slide and Prezi presentations.

Step 2: Open Icon Spotlight





Step 3: Set up




Once the software has been installed, out of the box the Logitech Spotlight will work as such: a Spotlight. This essentially highlights the area which is being pointed at. This is already a great feature, but we would advise to change from spotlight to digital laser.


As said, the pointer setting (see menu in image above) is set to be the Spotlight by default. Please adjust this and make the pointer a 'digital laser'. The Spotlight function basically darkens the whole slide, and highlights the area which is being pointed at. The digital laser is the closest we can get to reproduce a regular laser (which is what many lecturers on campus are used to and would like to use).


